Are you ready to work for UKCG companies?



New Standards for Supervisor Training introduced by UKCG

With effect from 1 January 2010 UKCG member companies are adopting a new supervisor training standard. The aim is to ensure that supervisors working on UKCG sites are able to demonstrate that they have the necessary knowledge and skills to supervise their workers effectively.

Supervisors must be able to demonstrate that they have satisfied the following criteria:

- Sufficient knowledge of health and safety gained at a construction-specific course of at least two days duration.
- Sufficient skills to be an effective supervisor. They will need to demonstrate an understanding of behavioural issues, leadership and effective intervention skills. The training must therefore include the delivery of basic level training including tool box talks.

UKCG are to require identified supervisors for all sizes of work gang. This extends to non-English speaking workers who need supervision from someone who is able to communicate effectively with them. The ratio of supervisors to workers will be established on the basis of an employer's risk assessment, made in conjunction with the Principal Contractor.

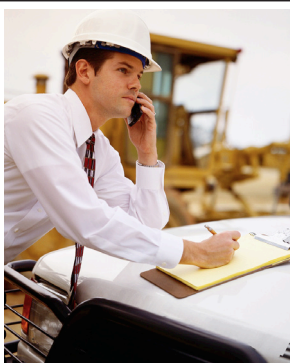
Regarding this new initiative, Stephen Ratcliffe, Director of UKCG commented: "UKCG has identified the need to tighten up the competence of supervisors to help improve health and safety performance. This standard is the means by which members will tackle the issue."
